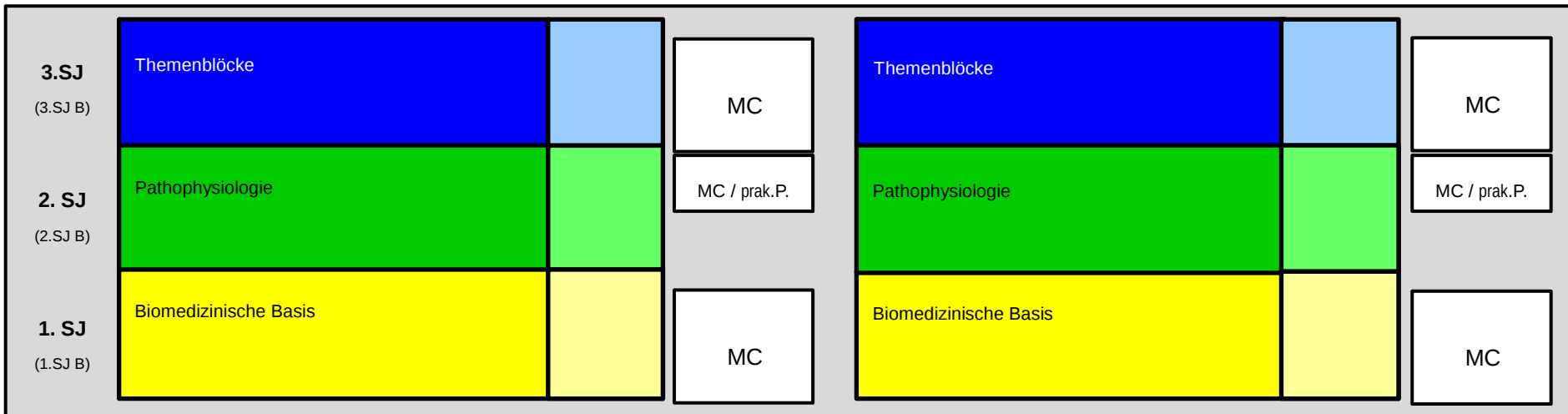
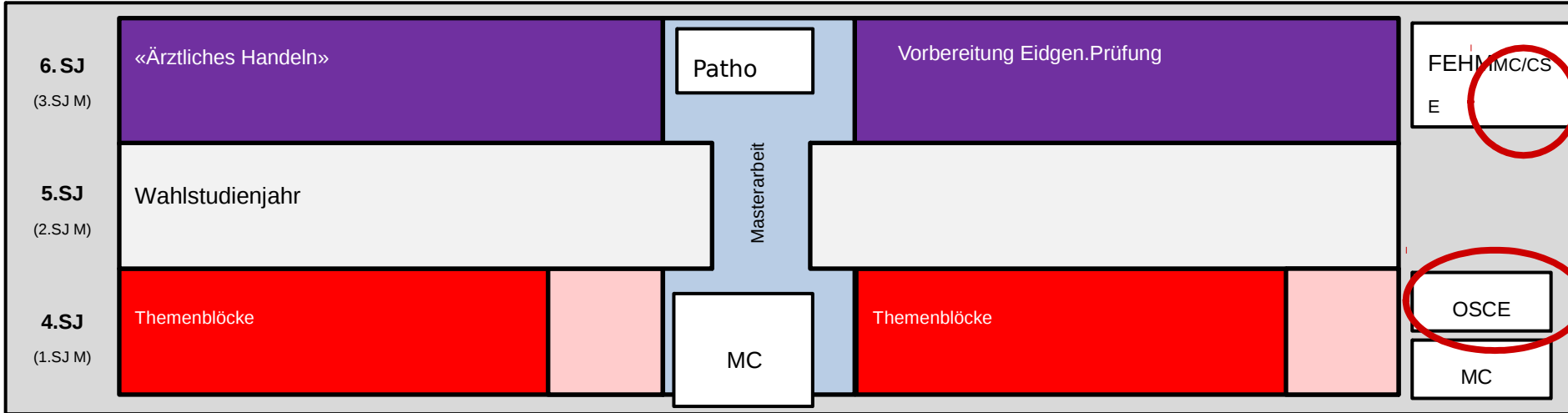

12 stations per student (OSCE: 8 stations)

2 „resting“ stations

13 + 2 min per station (OSCE with feedback; CSE: no feedback)

2 runs per day (identical) / separation by briefing session



Selection of cases: nationwide process, heavily involving local faculty

Final selection based on SCLO blueprint (chapter: „Problems as Starting Points for Training“)

Central **piloting of cases** (2 cases per day, mixed teams)

Local **SP casting & training** (ZH: 170 SPs)



OSCE: 4 days (2 parallel runs)

CSE:

- 3 days, 3 parallel runs each day (ZH),
- time per candidate: 3.5 hrs
- same cases over one day, separation of cohorts by briefing session
- nationwide synchronisation, observers from IML / other sites

(partly) e-assessment (tablets),



History taking, (physical) Status, Management (HSM): **75 %**

Communication Competencies (CC): **25 %**

Total: $0.75 * \text{HSM} + 0.25 * \text{CC}$

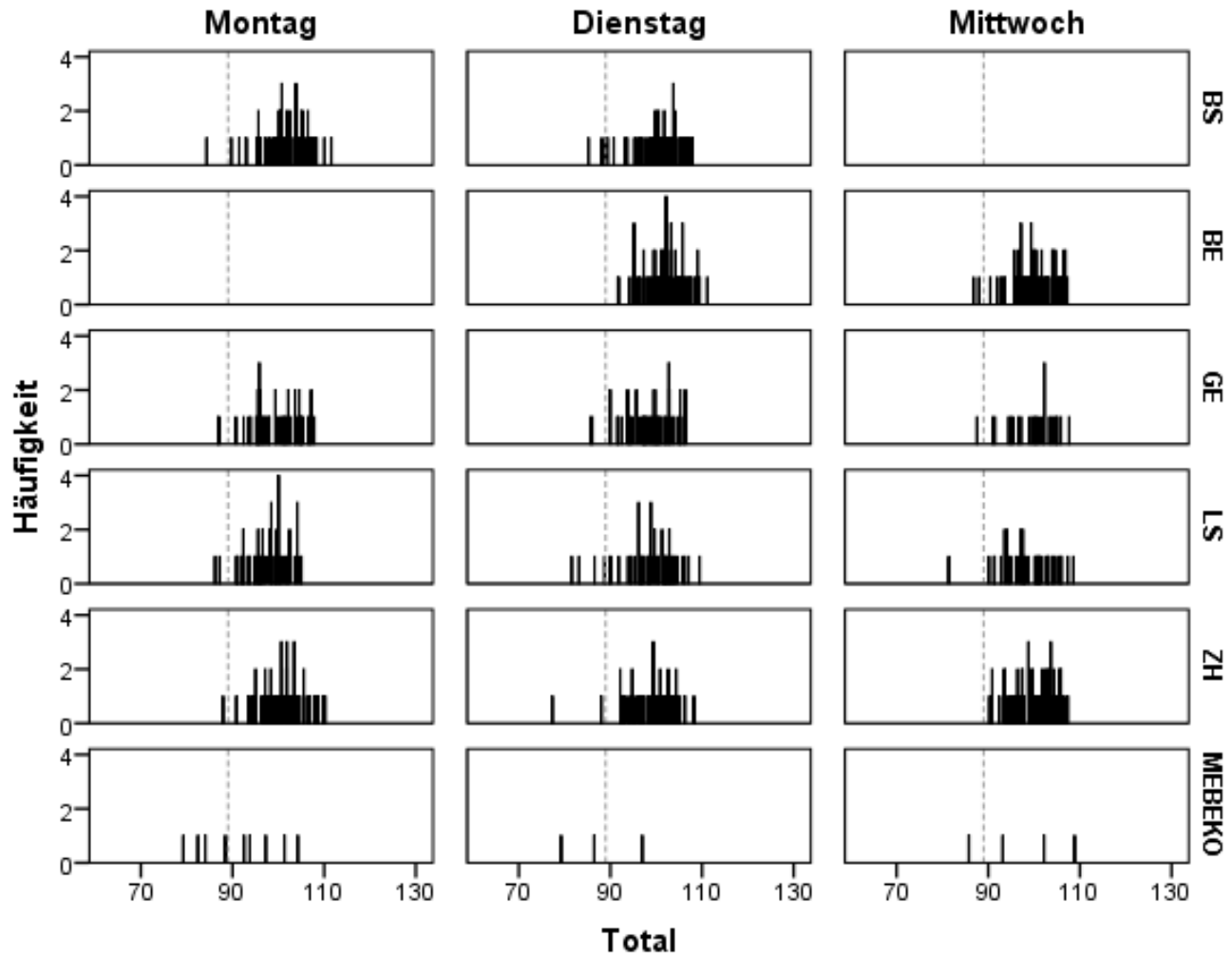

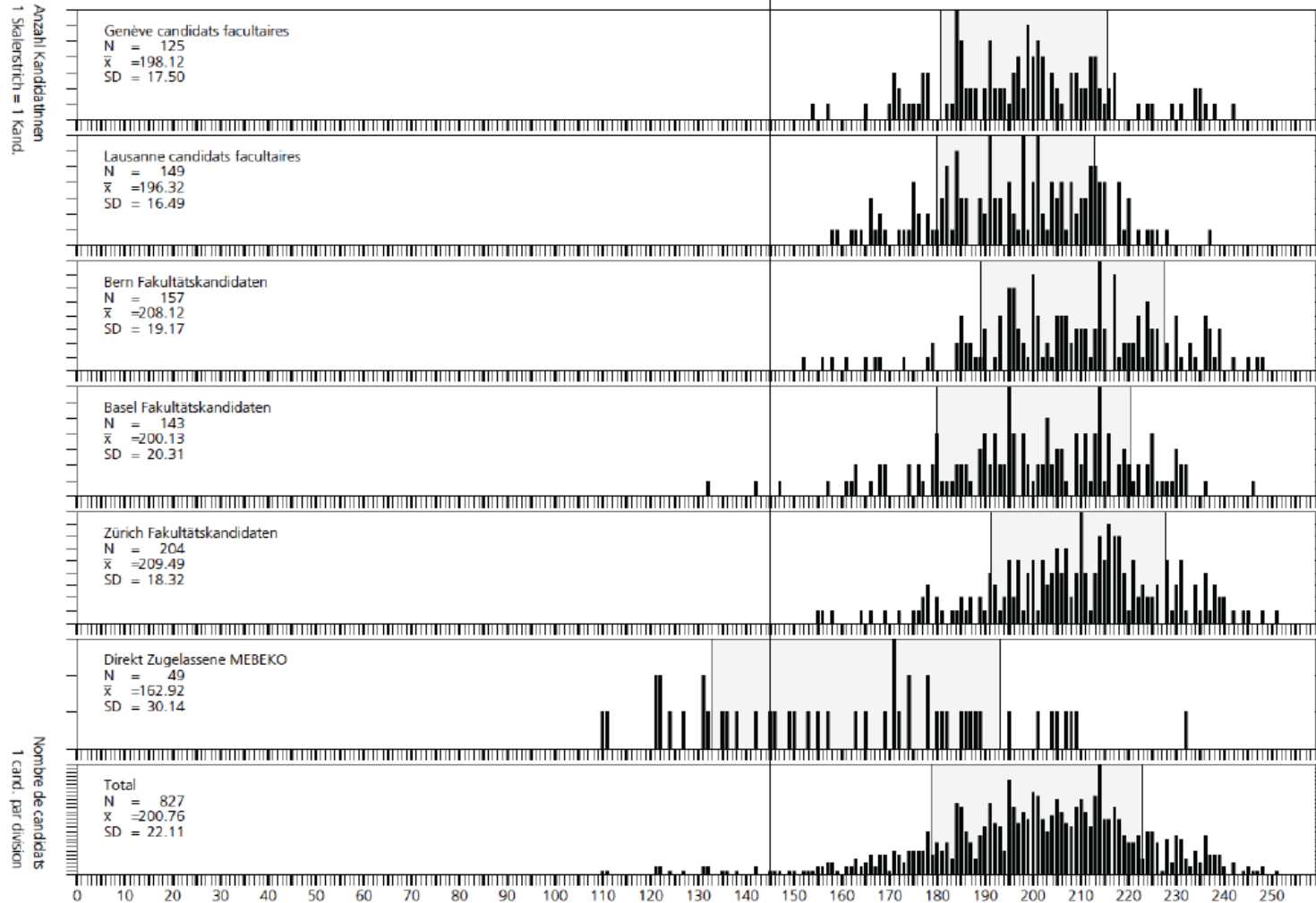
